



NORTH CAROLINA ACTIVE MILITARY

North Carolina is home to many of the renowned military installations in the nation and thousands of brave service members stationed at them. Each Installation in North Carolina provides unique and critical capabilities that contribute to our National Security and support the National Defense Authorization Act and National Military Strategy. North Carolina installations play a significant and enduring critical role contributing to our National Defense. A brief description of North Carolina's major installations and their strategic contribution to national defense are listed.

U.S. ARMY FORT LIBERTY Home of the Airborne and Special Operations Forces, the Global Response Force, and is the nation's premier Power Projection Platform including U.S. Army Forces Command, XVIII Airborne Corps, U.S. Army Special Operations Command, U.S. Joint Special Operations Command, U.S. Army Reserve Command, among others.

MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP LEJEUNE. Home to the II Marine Expeditionary Force, 2nd Marine Division, 2nd Marine Logistics Group, Marine Forces Special Operations

Command, Marine Corps Installations Command East, and the USCG's Special Missions Training Center.

MARINE CORPS AIR STATION NEW RIVER. Marine Corps Air Station New River provides aviation support, force protection, infrastructure, and community services to promote the readiness, sustainment and quality of life for II MEF and other military forces, tenant commands, personnel and their families.

MARINE CORPS AIR STATION CHERRY POINT. The largest Marine Corps Air Station in the world and the future home to the largest F35B Joint Strike Fighter Base in the world. Fleet Readiness Center East and the future home to the F35B Depot Level Maintenance are highlighted tenants and facilities at the installation.

SEYMOUR JOHNSON AFB. 4th Fighter Wing and the entire Air Force's F15E Strike Eagle training capability. Basing location of the Reserve KC-46A Pegasus for the entire Air Force Reserve.

U.S. COAST GUARD BASE ELIZABETH CITY. Home to the Coast Guard's Air Station Elizabeth City, Aviation Logistics Center, Aviation Projects Acquisition Center, Aviation Technical Training Center, National Strike Force Coordination Center, and Small Boat Station Elizabeth City. The base is the largest employer in Northeastern North Carolina. **NORTH CAROLINA NATIONAL GUARD.** Providing more than 10,500 citizen soldiers to support Active Army. The Air National Guard provides critical assets to the Air Force.

MILITARY OCEAN TERMINAL SUNNY POINT. The largest ammunition port in the nation. As a key ammunition shipping point on the Atlantic coast, MOTSU stores and ships DOD ammunition, dangerous cargo and explosives, including small arms ammunition; artillery shells, fuses and propellants; ammunition for vehicle systems; and aircraft bombs and ammunition.

U.S. COAST GUARD SECTOR NORTH CAROLINA. Sector North Carolina has oversight of operational Coast Guard missions throughout the entire State of North Carolina. Their primary missions include Search and Rescue, Marine Safety, Ports and Waterways Coastal Security, Marine Environmental Protection, Aids to Navigation, Maritime Law Enforcement, and Recreational Boating Safety.

U.S. ARMY RESEARCH OFFICE. Funds extramural basic research, that is, research in outside academic and industrial organizations, providing grants to both single investigators and university-affiliated research centers, as well as outreach programs.

U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS WILMINGTON DISTRICT. The Wilmington District delivers vital engineering solutions in collaboration with our military and regional partners to secure the nation, energize the economy and reduce disaster risk across North Carolina and select regions of the Commonwealth of Virginia. The district provides expertise across a wide range of disciplines including: engineering, architecture, design, construction, hydropower, recreation management, hydrology and environmental stewardship.

You may be eligible to participate in SkillBridge if you have 180 days of service or fewer remaining prior to your date of separation and you have at least 180 continuous days of active service.




